



Announcing program updates to expand access and equity in cancer care

The American Cancer Society Leadership in Oncology Navigation (ACS LION™) is a standardized training, credentialing, and implementation support program that helps patient navigators deliver essential nonclinical support to individuals, caregivers, and families facing cancer.

New program updates reflect our commitment to removing barriers and increasing access to high-quality training for cancer care professionals and navigators:

- The program is now offered at no cost.
- Live proctoring is no longer required.
- Spanish-language option is coming soon.

The ACS LION™ program meets the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) training requirements for principal illness navigation reimbursement and is aligned to Oncology Navigation Standards of Professional Practice.

Patient navigation has historically been inconsistent in availability and scope. ACS LION addresses this gap through standardized training and credentialing that expands access to high-quality navigation services, reduces barriers, and supports equitable cancer care.


